Pharmacy Prior Authorization

With the implementation of KanCare on January 1, 2013, Xerox State Healthcare, LLC, will no longer be responsible for processing pharmacy-related prior authorizations (PAs). This includes PAs established through point-of-sale transactions and the enhanced PA call center.

Beginning January 1, 2013, most PAs must be requested through the beneficiary's designated health plan. For those few populations that remain traditional fee-for-service, HP will process the PA requests.
