FY 2022 Hospice Payment Rates

Effective with claims processing November 10, 2021, and retroactive to dates of service on and after October 1, 2021, hospice services will be reimbursed in accordance with the federal fiscal year (FFY) 2022 policy. The rates are based on provider compliance with submission of required hospice quality data in accordance with Section 3004 of the Affordable Care Act.

The new rates have been updated in the Hospice Fee-for-Service Provider Manual.

The following codes must be billed based on the county of the hospice provider:

The following codes must be billed based upon the county of the member:

T2043 G0299 U2 G0155

CMS is providing updated examples of the Hospice Election Statement and the Hospice Election Statement Addendum that reflect the changes finalized in the FY 2020 hospice final rule (84 FR 38520) to assist hospices in understanding the content requirements for the Hospice Election Statement and addendum, effective October 1, 2021. These requirements were finalized to increase coverage transparency for members electing for the Medicare hospice benefit. Note: The effective date of the policy is October 1, 2021. The implementation of State policy by the KanCare managed care organizations (MCOs) may vary from the date noted in the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) bulletins. The **KanCare Open Claims Resolution Log** on the KMAP <u>Bulletins</u> page documents the MCO system status for policy implementation and any associated reprocessing completion dates once the policy is implemented.
