KMAP GENERAL BULLETIN 21251

RHC and FQHC Optometry Codes

Effective with dates of service on and after January 1, 2022, Rural Health Centers and Federally Qualified Health Centers (RHC/FQHC) providers will be allowed to bill HCPCS codes 92002, 92004, 92012, and 92014 with Place of Service (POS) code 50 or 72. Frames and lenses will be billed separately by the optometry provider.

These codes will be paid at the appropriate prospective payment system (PPS) rate.

Note: The effective date of the policy is January 1, 2022. The implementation of State policy by the KanCare managed care organizations (MCOs) may vary from the date noted in the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) bulletins. The KanCare Open Claims Resolution Log on the KMAP Bulletins page documents the MCO system status for policy implementation and any associated reprocessing completion dates once the policy is implemented.
